Accept it!

You will receive your badge by email. Click 'Claim your badge' and you will be prompted to set up a myHPass profile or add the badge to your existing one, [learn more here](#).



Add it to your myHPass profile

Complete your profile so that it is telling the best possible story of your skills. Make sure your profile is public, you could add a link to your myHPass profile on your CV.



Make it public

Ensure your badge is public so it can be searched for and viewed by peers and potential employers looking for specific learning and skills.



Share it on social media

Share on your social platforms and consider including it in your signature.
